I have held courses in sketching and drawing techniques as well as held animation courses and mentored students at various design schools (see below). In September 2008, I was invited by Svenska Institutet (The Swedish Institute) to be one of two Swedes in the jury at the Cellflix Film Festival in Shanghai, China. The festival was a celebration of Bergman's 90 years and took place in the beginning of September, 2008 in Shanghai. I have also been invited to be one of three jury members of the Swedish competition at Uppsala Short Film Festival 2009 – the largest film festival for short films in Sweden. In 2015 I was a jury member at the same festival, now for the international competition. The same year, I was "filmmaker in focus" at the festival, including a retrospective showing nine of my films.

My animated short film "Benjamin's Flowers" (Benjamins blommor) premiered in October 2012. It has been awarded at Stockholm International Film Festival, the largest competitive film festival in Northern Europe and has been selected to compete, as one of 65 films (and one of 10 animated short films) out of 8,102

submissions at the *Sundance Film Festival 2013* – one of the world's biggest film festivals. It has also been selected for *Liljevalchs Vårsalong 2013*, the famous jury-selected Spring Salon exhibition marks the opening of each new artistic year at Liljevalchs Art Gallery in Stockholm. It has been selected to more than 60 film festivals around the world and premiered at *cinemas all across Sweden* in October, 2013, through Folket Bio. My animated short film “But You Are a Dog”, premiered in January 2014 at Göteborg International Film Festival where it was nominated for “*Startsladden*” – Best Swedish Short Film – one of the biggest awards for short film in the world. It has also been selected to compete for *Best Swedish Short Film* at Uppsala International Short Film Festival 2014 as well for the *1 km film-scholarship* at Stockholm International Film Festival. It has been screened at several other festivals around the world and premiered at *cinemas all across Sweden* on October 16, 2014, through Folket Bio. It has also been selected for *Liljevalchs Vårsalong 2015* at Liljevalchs Art Gallery in Stockholm. In January 2015 the film was nominated for a *Guldbagge Award* for Best Short Film 2014. My most recent animated short film is “Sleep Incidents” (2016). The film is financed by the Swedish Film Institute and co-produced by Sveriges Television (Swedish Television) and Johan Ribe/iFilm. It premiered at Göteborg International Film Festival in January 2016 and had its cinema premiere on March 30, 2016. It premiered on television on SVT1 in August, 2016 and is now available on SVT Play (Sweden only).
